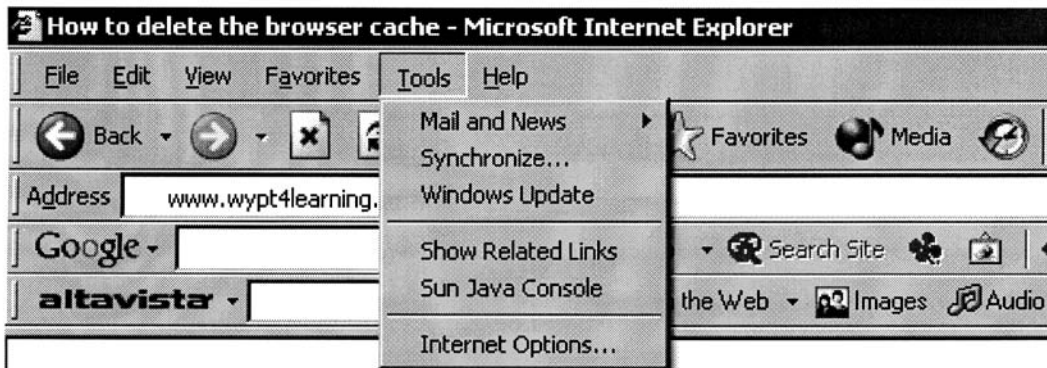


BROWSER TIPS

Delete the Cache and Set 'Days to Keep in History'

Web browsers download pages and store them locally on your machine in an area called "cache." Delete all of the files in your cache directory to speed Web page loading. Clearing the cache ensures that any individuals using a browser session after you on the same machine (particularly on public machines) will not see your private information. Setting fewer days to keep links to pages you visited in the History folder and/or clearing 'history' will also speed things up.



- Go to Tools --- Internet Options
- Under 'Temporary Internet Files', click on Delete Files.
- Click OK button.
- Click OK.

- Under History, type in the number of days to keep links to pages you've recently viewed. (Estimate a low number; you can change it later.)
- Consider clicking 'Clear History' to start fresh with no links saved in the History folder.
